SRST Game & Fish – Animal Control Division has received numerous reports, complaints, and photographs involving prohibited animals being kept within the Standing Rock Sioux Reservation.

To promote public safety and ensure compliance with tribal laws and regulations, SRST Game & Fish – Animal Control will conduct a

Voluntary Surrender Program throughout June 3, 2026 – June 30, 2026.

During this period, individuals who currently possess prohibited animals may voluntarily surrender them to SRST Game & Fish – Animal Control **without receiving citations/penalties and surrender fees**. All citations associated with the voluntary surrender of prohibited animals will be waived during the program period.

This initiative is intended to:

- Enhance community safety.
- Protect residents.
- Encourage compliance with tribal animal control regulations.
- Provide a safe and responsible means of surrendering prohibited animals.

Prohibited animals includes:

- **Rottweilers**
- **Doberman Pinschers**
- **Any dog commonly known as “Pit Bulls”**

Including American Bullies, American Pit Bull Terriers, American Bullies, American Staffordshire Terriers, and Staffordshire Bull Terriers.

Community members are encouraged to contact SRST Game & Fish. Animal Control personnel will work with owners to ensure the animals are handled appropriately and humanely.
